

Temporary moratorium on fishing

What's happening?

The City of Pine Lake has approved a temporary moratorium on fishing. This means no one can fish in Pine Lake until further notice. Fishing will resume at a later date; this is not a permanent ban.

Why can't I fish?

Items like fishing line, spools, lures, and hooks are left around the lake. These items are dangerous for people, pets, and wild animals. The city needs time to clean up the lake and put procedures in place to make the lake safe for all to enjoy.
